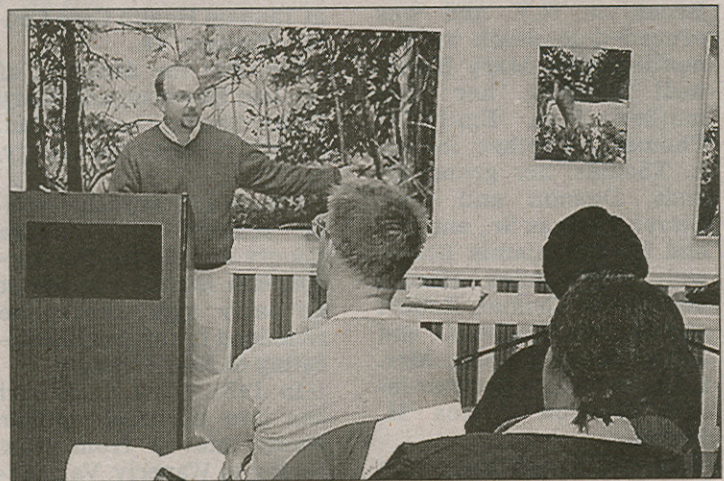
Attorney explores roles of landlords, tenants

PETERSBURG — On Monday evening, the Petersburg Public Library System's William R. McKenney Library had a full audience to learn more about the "Landlord Tenant Relationship."

Attorney Steve Dickinson with the Legal Aid Justice Center reviewed the rights and responsibilities of the parties involved. Contracts were reviewed, as were specific federal laws and regulation pertinent to Virginal leases.

Many questions were asked and answered allowing for a clear and precise understanding of the law pertinent to audience concerns.

Communication styles and the proper handling of "when things go wrong" were stressed.
