

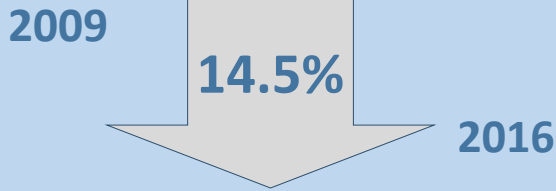
Virginia's School-to-Prison Pipeline



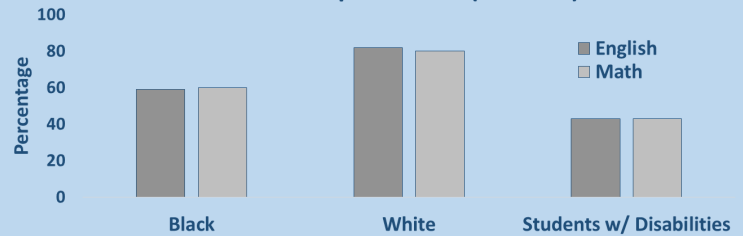
Resource starvation, unaddressed academic failure, suspension and expulsion, and school policing are pushing students out of school and into the juvenile and criminal justice systems.



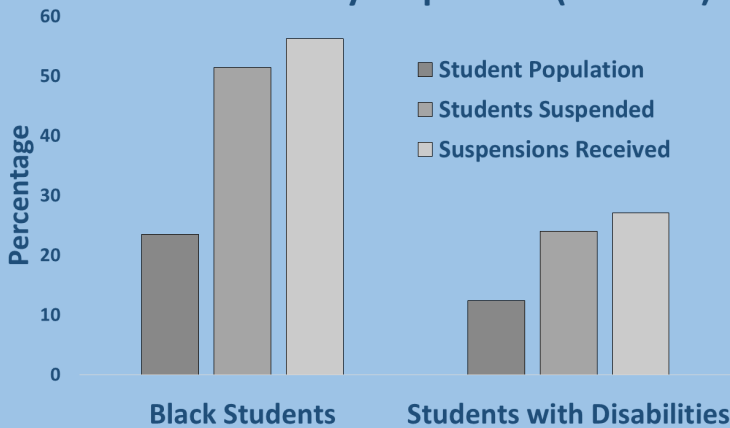
State Per Pupil Education Funding

Race & Disability Disparities (2012-13)



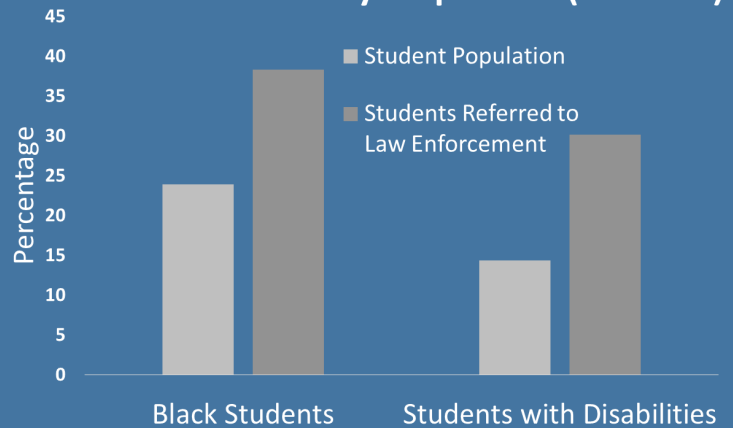
Out-of-School Suspension & Expulsion (2012-13)

137,151 short-term suspensions
 5,517 long-term suspensions
 518 expulsions
 78,941 students suspended or expelled
 27,568 suspensions to 16,019 elementary school students

School-Based Arrests & Court Referrals (2011-12)

- 1 highest rate in U.S. for students referred to law enforcement
- 17,863 students referred to law enforcement
- 0 laws or regulations limiting arrests and court referrals for minor misbehavior
