#### Have You Lost Employer-Sponsored Health Insurance?

## The Affordable Care Act May Help

When you lose health insurance provided through your job:

- You get a <u>Special Enrollment Period</u> to sign up for insurance through the ACA
- This is true whether or not you have ever used the ACA before
- You have 60 days before or after the last day your job-based insurance to use the ACA
- Act promptly as soon as you know your employer-sponsored insurance will end

### Virginia's Medicaid Program May Help

Do I qualify for Medicaid coverage?

- Compare your current monthly income, not your usual monthly income to those on this chart
- If your current monthly income for your family size is below the Medicaid-eligible threshold, apply for Medicaid
- Still not sure? Go to https://coverva.org/ and click on "Am I Eligible?" to check.

You can apply for Medicaid in any of the following ways:

- Call your county or city Dept. of Social Services office. Staffs are retrieving messages and returning calls.
- Call the statewide hotline at 1-855-635-4370. Wait times can be long but this may be the easiest route to take.
