

# Renewing a Driver Privilege Card

## How can I renew my privilege card?

The DMV will send you a renewal application approximately 90 days before your privilege card expires. You also have the option to receive the application by email by visiting this link:

You must make sure your current address is on file with the DMV, and if your address changes, you must notify the DMV of the change.

## How much will it cost to renew my privilege card?

The renewal fee for the privilege card is \$50.

## How long will my privilege card be valid?

**A new law will take effect on July 1 that will extend the validity period of the privilege card.** This law will extend the duration of the privilege card to 8 years. However, if your privilege card expires before July 1, 2026, it will only be renewed for a 2-year term, and when it is time to renew again, it will then be valid for 8 years.

\*\*You may renew your privilege card up to six months before its expiration date. However, if you renew it before it expires, the remaining time left on the current card will not be added to the new validity period.\*\*

# Renewing a Driver Privilege Card

## What are my options for renewing my privilege card?

### 1. RENEW ONLINE OR BY MAIL

You may renew your privilege card online or by mail every other renewal cycle, except if your card is expired, suspended, or revoked. If you renew online or by mail, the DMV will use the photo currently on your existing privilege card.

**The DMV will mail the renewal application 90 days before your privilege card expires.**

When you renew online, you will receive a temporary privilege card that you can print and carry along with your expired license.

***Please allow at least 15 days to receive your new Driver Privilege Card before contacting the DMV.***

#### Renew by Mail

Please review the renewal application you received in the mail. Make sure your address, height, and weight are correct. If any information on the application is incorrect, make the necessary changes on the application before mailing it. You may also change your organ donor status if you wish. If any other information is incorrect, you may call the DMV at (804) 497-7100. From there, you can speak with an agent and explain what needs to be corrected.

You must make sure to do the following:

- Complete all questions on the application
- Sign and date the application
- Mail the application along with your payment in the same envelope to the following address: Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles P.O Box 26506 Richmond, VA 23260

### 2. RENEWING YOUR PRIVILEGE CARD AT A CUSTOMER SERVICE CENTER

If you cannot renew your privilege card by mail or online, and you need to make sure your card remains valid, you are required to:

- Schedule an appointment to be seen in person
- Complete and submit the DPC (Driver Privilege Card) application:

- Present your expired privilege card or another accepted form of identification from List A: <https://www.dmv.virginia.gov/webdoc/pdf/dmv309.pdf>
- Successfully complete the DMV vision exam or submit an acceptable Customer Vision Report
- Pay the renewal fee by check, cash, money order, or credit card
- Have your photo taken

If your name has changed, you must bring one of the following proof documents to update your name in DMV records:

- Marriage certificate or civil union document filed with a government agency or court. **NOTE: Marriage licenses or marriage certificates signed only by the wedding officiant (for example, a clergy member) will not be accepted.**
- Divorce decree, if the decree states the change from your married last name back to your maiden name
- Court order granting the name change

When you renew your privilege card, you will receive a temporary driving permit to carry along with your previous privilege card.

***Please allow at least 15 days to receive your new Driver Privilege Card before contacting the DMV.***
